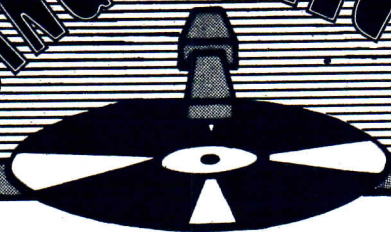


# GOING ON RECORD

## Star Singles:

**"SONGBIRD"—Barbra Streisand.** A lot of violins on this mel-low one from Barbra. She sounds like her old self again after her rock 'n' roll phase! (Columbia)

**"HOPELESSLY DEVOTED"—Olivia Newton-John.** This is the third single released from the "Grease" soundtrack—the first by Olivia and John Travolta, then the title theme by Frankie Valli (sure to be a favorite!)—"Hopelessly Devoted." (RSO)

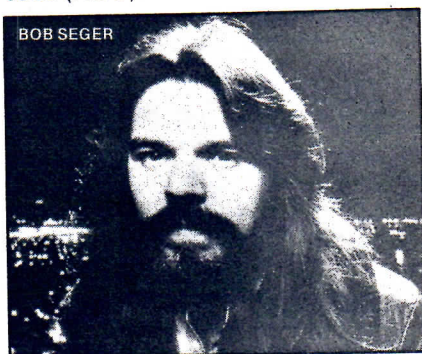
**"MISS YOU"—Rolling Stones.** Mick Jagger does some talking and some singing on this one—the first in a long time from the Rolling Stones! It's from their newest album and it's pretty heavy blues. (Atlantic)



## Star Albums:

**"SHADOW DANCING"—Andy Gibb.** This album is a "must" for everyone's record collection if you're at all in love with Andy Gibb (and who isn't?). It features his hit single "Shadow Dancing," plus "Melody," "(Our Love)

Don't Throw It All Away" and a couple others we think are terrific. He wrote six of the songs, and some with brother Barry, too. (RSO).



**"STRANGER IN TOWN"—Bob Seger & Silver Bullet Band.** First came his fabulous single "Night Moves" and then "Still the Same"! "Stranger in Town" has that song on it, plus a lot of other goodies. (Capitol)

## Glimmers:

There's a little bit of everything in your record stores nowadays—if you like punkish rock, there's IGGY POP's "TV Eye" album... if you like softer music, there's BARBRA STREISAND's "Songbird" album or ENGELBERT HUMPERDINCK's newest LP, "Last of the Romantics"... JOE WALSH has an album out in the form of "But Seriously, Folks," with all the other Eagles backing him up with singing and playing—but it still sounds very Joe Walsh and not too much Eagles... CAROLE KING, whose teenage daughter is just about to jump into the recording business, has an album out herself—"Welcome Home," and it's one of her best.
