Star Singles:

GOING IN WITH MY EYES OPEN—David Soul. A nifty romantic song by David, and there's no doubt he's got another hit! Some great harmony with the background voices, too. (Private Stock)



PEOPLE IN LOVE—10cc. This one is kind of like "The Things We Do For Love," and I guess if you've found a formula, stick with it. Synthesizers are used in this. (Mercury)

MUSIC TO MY HEART—Julie Budd. She's been around forever, and this one might be the record to make her a star! It's very disco (unlike her previous records). The flip side ("Someone to Light Up My Life") is still disco, but could be a great romantic record, too. (Alston)

Star Albums:



EAR CANDY—Helen Reddy. With a new producer (Kim Fowley), who co-wrote some of the songs with

her, she has a different sound on this album. Some cajun-type music, disco-y ones, and her usual romantic numbers—her best album, we think. (Capitol)



LACE AND WHISKEY—Alice Cooper. Alice has been working on this one a long time, and it turned out great! A bit more sophisticated than some of his previous albums, and it has "You and Me," his hit single on it (how can you go wrong?). (Warner Bros.)

IT'S A GAME—Bay City Rollers. The Rollers' new album has a great new feeling with such good tunes like "Love Power," Dance, Dance, Dance" and even a Bowie song! (Arista)

Glimmers:

Singles—NEIL SEDAKA has his first single out in a while—"Amarillo," and it's from his first album on Elektra Records, which'll be out real soon . . . "Splish Splash," BOBBY DARIN'S old hit, has been re-released by—FRANKIE AVALON! . . . THELMA HOUSTON's newest is "If You Won't Let Me Walk on the Water" . . . ENGLAND DAN & JOHN FORD COLEY have another hit with "It's Sad to Belong."
