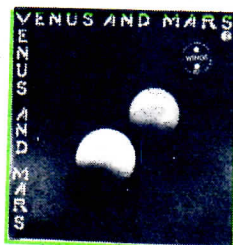

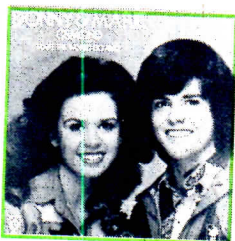
**Tony DeFranco: "WE BELONG TOGETHER."**
