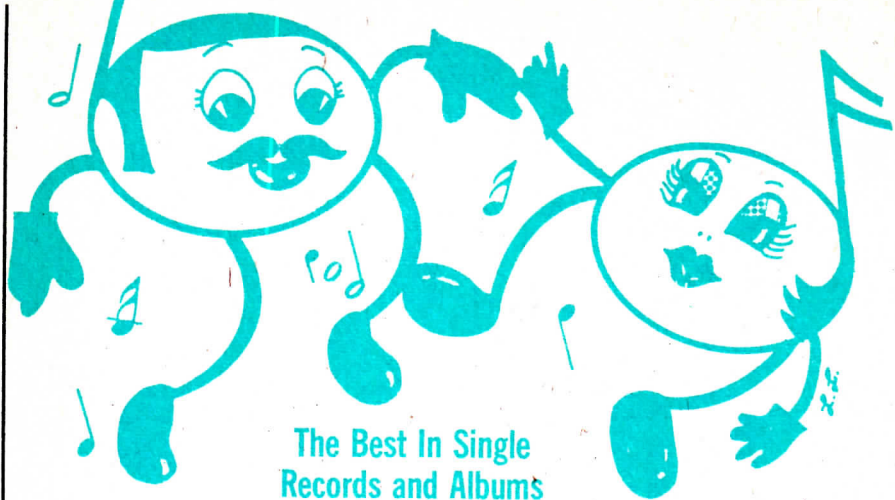

The Best In Single Records and Albums

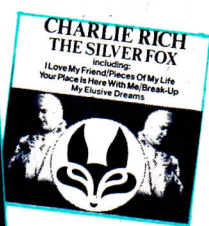
• BEST SINGLES

• SUPER ALBUMS

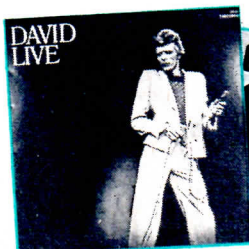
