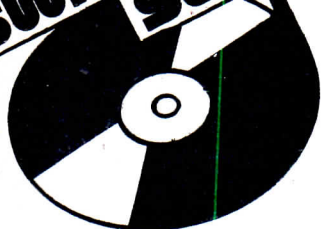

John Denver: "SPIRIT." Just like all his other great albums, John Denver's newest one will most likely go straight to the top without any problem at all! John sings of the mountains he loves, the people he loves and he even has some light humored songs that pick up the pace. Best cuts on the LP are "Like A Sad Song," "Come and Let Me Look In Your Eyes," "Wrangle Mountain Song," and "In The Grand Way." (RCA)

Linda Ronstadt: "HASTEN DOWN THE WIND." "Hasten Down the Wind," even though it's like Linda's other albums with its country and rock combination with some oldies but goodies mixed in, has a super sound that comes alive with Linda's strong, sexy voice. Linda started from the bottom of the record business quite a few years back and this album proves that she's really made it!
