Paul Anka: "ANKA." If "Having My Baby" is a favorite song of yours, you can expect more of the same from Paul's new album release! Paul has a smooth, easy listening style that we think you'll like! Did you know Paul originally recorded and wrote Donny Osmond's hit record "Puppy Love"? (United Artists)

Harry Nilsson: "PUSSY CATS." This is a terrific album—especially if you love the Beatles, because it was produced by John Lennon and Ringo Starr plays drums! You should enjoy Nilsson's version of "Save

the Last Dance For Me" and "Rock Around the Clock!" (RCA)

Not the picture, the way it opens out! Inside you'll find half a dozen nice shots of Diana performing!
