THE EAGLES

**Eagles: "THEIR GREATEST HITS"**... gives you just what the title implies—and that's a lot! All of those songs you loved them for for so long, are all together on this super album! Which ever was your favorite (although, if you're like us, you probably have several!), "The Best Of My Love," or "Peaceful, Easy Feelin," they're all here! (Asylum)

**Boz Scaggs: "SILK DEGREES."** This album is dynamite! Even after thirty-two weeks on the chart, it still remains number three! There's so many good songs on this album it would be hard to pick out just two or three, but favorites are, of course, "It's Over," and "Lowdown" which were two of the man's biggest hits!
